Palm Desert, CA – Burton Cummings, lead singer of the original The Guess Who and a successful solo artist, is set to tour the US beginning this September, marking his 60-year anniversary of making and releasing music. Cummings and his band will appear at the McCallum Theatre for one night only, on Wednesday, January 15 at 7:00pm.

Tickets go on sale to the general public this Friday, July 19 at 10:00am. Current McCallum Theatre donors will be given presale access on Thursday, July 18 at 10:00am. All others who have opted in to receive email offers from the McCallum will be given presale access on Thursday, July 18 at 4:00pm. All presale access will close at 10:00pm on Thursday, July 18. Single tickets for this performance are priced at \$125, \$95, and \$75.

In 1964, a 16-year-old Cummings released two singles as a member of The Deverons. Just two years later, he joined The Guess Who. It was with the original The Guess Who that Cummings' signature vocals, along with his songwriting and keyboard prowess would fuel massively big hits around the world including "These Eyes," "No Time," "Laughing," and their biggest hit, "American Woman." The latter track topped the Billboard Hot 100 for three weeks in 1970. Following the band's breakup in 1975, Cummings found solo success with "Stand Tall," an international hit that spent 21 weeks on the Billboard Hot 100, peaking at #10.

Today, Cummings remains at the top of his game as an unrivaled singer, songwriter, showman, and recording artist. Don't miss your chance to see this music legend live!

Cummings shares, "Get ready, America! This fall, my band and I are hitting the road for our US tour," shares Cummings. "It's been far too long, but we're finally bringing the music straight to your doorstep.
