The McCallum Theatre volunteer usher team has a long tradition of excellent service, professionalism, and incomparable hospitality. They are truly ambassadors of the theatre as they are among the first representatives that the public will meet while attending events at the theatre.

We strive to make our volunteer program an enjoyable experience where great friendships are made. This is why we have been able to keep so many of our volunteers with us year after year – some have been with us since the Theatre's opening in 1988.

Volunteer ushers perform a variety of theatre responsibilities – scanning tickets, monitoring lobby doors, helping patrons find assigned seats and distributing programs. Assignments vary from day to day based on theatre needs.

VOLUNTEERS MUST BE ABLE TO MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Available to volunteer for a minimum of 8 shows per month from December through May. Volunteer commitments during September, October, November, and June are lighter, with fewer shows scheduled.
- Comfortable with email and learning the volunteer computer program.
- Ability to stand for up to three hours.
- Able to climb steps to help patrons on the balcony and mezzanine levels.
- Maintain a cheerful outlook (friendly & helpful).
- Provide black dress slacks and black closed-toe shoes to wear with uniform top provided by the theatre.
